

LEGAL HELP WITH EVICTIONS

PROVIDING QUALIFYING LOW INCOME FAMILIES
AND INDIVIDUALS WITH EVICTION-RELATED LEGAL
ASSISTANCE

ELIGIBLE TENANTS MAY:

- Get legal assistance with your eviction.
- Resolve your eviction with a settlement instead of a judgment.
- Get connected to resources to help you maintain housing or move to a more affordable unit.

LANDLORDS MAY:

- Get payment or possession after just 1 court hearing.
- Get eviction case resolved without physically appearing in court.

TENANTS MAY GET HELP BY:

- ASK to speak to Legal Services at your eviction court hearing.
